

To recognize an official taxis

Only taxis located at the gates mentioned above (Cf. "taxis location") are allowed to take customers. These taxis can be identified by the "light" on the roof of the vehicle.

If you are approached by people posing as taxi, when leaving the baggage claim area, we invite you to decline any proposal of transportation. Find out more information



Taxis location

To leave the airport, you will find taxis at the exit to the baggage reclaim area of your arrival terminal: <u>Terminal 1</u>: exit 24 on the arrivals level / <u>Terminal 2A</u>: exit 6 / <u>Terminal 2C</u>: exit 14 / <u>Terminal 2D</u>: exit 7 / <u>Terminal 2E</u>: gate 10 on the arrivals level / <u>Terminal 2F</u>: gate 11 ont the arrivals level / <u>Terminal 3</u>: exit of the arrivals hall / <u>Terminal 2G</u>: blue gate

Your journey by BUS

To leave and / or join the Paris-Charles de Gaulle airport by BUS

RoissyBus provides a direct service between Central Paris (Opéra) and Paris-Charles de Gaulle airport. The RoissyBus stop is at 11 rue du Scribe, 75009 Paris. The journey time is approx. 1hr15 mins.

Buses run between 5.15am and 12.30am to Paris-Charles de Gaulle airport and between 6am and 12.30am from the airport. They leave every 15/20 minutes.**Price:**
